

# Problem Statement

Desktop Wrapper API is a contract between the Symphony App (currently closed source and implemented by the LLC) and any other Desktop Wrapper that implements the API. The open source Symphony Electron project is a reference implementation of such a Desktop Wrapper. Changes to the Symphony App can break a wrapper implementation - resulting in production bugs. Strong communication channels between the LLC and 3rd party dev groups - facilitated by the Desktop Wrapper WG - will mitigate these issues so that 3rd parties can be aware of pending changes, provide feedback on proposed changes, etc.

# Proposed Process

1. Reviewing any pending or proposed changes impacting the SSF API should be maintained as the highest priority item on the agenda for the Desktop Wrapper working group.
2. In the Symphony Electron project, add a specific label - e.g. "SSF API" - that can be used for pull requests impacting the APIs. This will make it much easier to track changes that could affect APIs as well as for members of the WG to comment on those changes.
3. Tracking Beta changes will be responsibility of 3rd party implementers - who will need to maintain Beta Pods.
4. Beta > Prod dates should be available to 3rd party implementers (if not already).
